Since 1912 The Rocky Mountain Coal Mining Institute has been promoting coal through education. The mission has evolved over the years to include a scholarship program, started in 1984, and public education funding that began in 2002.

We are proud of the accomplishments the Institute has achieved. We believe that to keep the country strong and energy-efficient, we must educate our students and the general public.

Patrons

The Patron Program began in 1984 for the purpose of giving two-year scholarships to students in their junior and/or senior year at college. They must be engineering or geology majors with the intent of entering the coal industry.

Both individuals as well as corporations fund this program on a yearly basis with contributions from \$100 to \$5,000 or more. Matching company gifts are also important to this very valuable program.

Since 2007 the Institute has also been awarding eight Technical Scholarships for those taking classes that will support the industry.

RMCMCI awards over \$40,000 from the Patron Program per year.

Convention Sponsorships

In 2002 the Board of Directors felt it was necessary to do more in the area of public education. The convention sponsorship program was born and we are proud of our company sponsors who contribute approximately \$100,000 each year for RMCMCI to reach out and educate the public. In 2007 our first major accomplishment was an educational Kiosk that has a permanent home in the Leadville, Colorado Mining Museum. In 2009 the first traveling Kiosk was built so that members of the Institute may use it to educate classrooms, service groups, and others in the eight RMCMCI member states.

The majority of the Convention Sponsorships are \$2,500 with headline sponsorships priced higher. Supporting sponsors receive name recognition for \$500. The RMCMCI website homepage identifies the many sponsorships available and explains what your company will receive in return for your generous contribution.

Approximately 450-500 attend the convention each year.

Regional Sponsorships

Three Regional Meetings are held each year. Arizona and New Mexico as well as Colorado and Utah both hold meetings in the spring. In September the states of Montana, North Dakota and Wyoming meet.

These meetings are educational meetings for those members that may not be able to attend the annual convention as well as those non-members wishing to learn more about RMCMCI. The attendance ranges from 50 to over 100 with quality, industry speakers offering the latest information on various topics at both the evening banquet and the morning technical sessions. Mines and power plants are sometimes made available for site tours.
